Crown Point Historic Preservation Commission

As we enter spring and the upcoming summer, The Crown Point Historic Preservation Commission would like to remind all residents and business owners within the Holley Residential Historic District, Courthouse Square Historic District, Sunnyside Residential Historic District and the Eastside Residential Historic District, that any exterior changes or changes visible from the street must follow the design guidelines specific to each historic district. For properties within the above historic districts the City of Crown Point requires a Certificate of Appropriateness to be issued for exterior changes including, but not limited to, roofs, windows, doors and painting.
