Approval of Claims and SRF Distributions

Including All Outstanding Claims and Obligations and Fixing a Time when the Same shall Take Effect. **(Second Reading and Adoption of 2022 Budget)**

Member Scott Evorik made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2021-09-18, seconded by Member Andrew Kyres.

Motion passed 5 to 2.

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Resolution No. 2021-10-25R - A Resolution of the City of Crown Point, Indiana Common Council Authorizing the Transfer of Monies to Fund the Operation of the Cities Newly Created P.A.C.E. Department.

Adam Graper stated that in the past, around this time of year, additional appropriations had been requested from the Parks Department. In attempts to avoid requesting additional monies from the Council, the P.A.C.E. Department is requesting to transfer funds from financially stable accounts.

Member Laura Sauerman made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2021-10-25R, seconded by Member Carol Drasga.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
