**WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND IDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT**

Please read this Waiver and Release of all Claims and Indemnification Agreement carefully and completely and be cognizant that in consideration for permission to use the City of Crown Point Dog Park facilities, you are specifically assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your dog might sustain as a result of using and/or participating in any and all activities associated with or connected with the use of the City of Crown Point Dog Park.

I hereby acknowledge that by the use of the City of Crown Point Dog Park for dog activities and engaging in dog activities while in the dog park, certain risks could result and said risks could be, but not limited to, damage, loss or injury to a dog, person(s), or property (including mine, other persons, other dogs, my dog or property of the dog park). I voluntarily agree to assume full risk and responsibility for any injuries, damages, loss, liability, costs, and expenses regardless of the amount that my dog, myself, or anyone accompanying me might sustain as a result of my being in the dog park facility; and, take full responsibility for any injury to another dog or person and for any property damaged sustained as a result of my dog's actions or my actions.

I do hereby agree to waive, abandon, release, and forever discharge the City of Crown Point, its Parks and Recreation Department, its officers, board members, employees, and agents; any volunteer working on behalf of the City of Crown Point Dog Park; including but not limited to any Foundation, its directors, board members, employees and agents from any and all claims for injuries, damages, loss, liability, or expenses that I may have or incur by me or to me hereafter or any person claiming through me or on my behalf and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated or connected with the use of the City of Crown Point Dog Park.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the City of Crown Point, its Parks and Recreation Department, any Foundation associated with the City of Crown Point Parks and Recreation Department, its officers, board members, employees and agents, and any volunteer working on behalf of the City of Crown Point Parks and Recreation Department from any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, causes of action and expenses including but not limited to attorney fees and court costs occurring or resulting directly or indirectly from my use of the City of Crown Point Dog Park including without limitation to any losses, claims, liabilities, damages, cause of actions and expenses on account of a personal injury, death to a person or dog, or damages to property of another person or the City of Crown Point Parks and Recreation Department.

I HAVE FULLY READ AND COMPLETELY UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE INFORMATION; WARNING OF RISK; ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS; AND, INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT.

*The City of Crown Point reserves the right to suspend or revoke park privileges to any member who fails to follow park rules, regulations, and etiquette or where the City of Crown Point has determined a member dog or their owner is dangerous to others or is in violation of an applicable animal ordinances or regulations.*

## RULES and REGULATIONS – CROWN POINT DOG PARK

The following Rules and Regulations shall apply for the use of the Crown Point Dog Park Facility by Participants/Uses, namely:

1. Only two (2) dogs per adult owner are allowed at one time. Both dogs must remain in the same run area with the owner. Owners shall not leave dogs without owner supervision.
2. Dogs must be leashed until inside run area. Maximum leash length is six (6) feet. No prong or pinch collars are allowed. Only buckle or stretch collars are permitted in the dog park for the dog's safety.
3. Children 11 and under are **NOT** allowed in run areas. Children 12 through 16 must be accompanied by an adult and are not to be left unattended in run areas.
4. Dogs must display current rabies tags.
5. Unhealthy dogs or those dogs in season are not allowed in the dog park.
6. It is recommended that dogs are on a regular flea and tick treatment in spring, summer, and fall.
7. Dogs under six (6) months of age are not permitted in the park.
8. Perpetual barking is not allowed as this is a nuisance to members and surrounding neighbors. If your dog will not stop barking you must leave the dog park.
9. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior must be removed from the dog park immediately. Offenders of this policy will lose their dog park privileges. Do not permit your dog to run to the gate when another dog is entering. Keep the gate area clear so that members can enter and exit without incidents.
10. Owners must clean up after their dog(s). Bags and waste receptacles are available.
11. Food, glass containers, smoking or chewing of tobacco, and alcohol are not allowed on the dog park premises. Small bite sized training treats are permitted.
12. Bicyclists, skateboarders, roller skates, roller blading, and all other motorized or human-propelled devices (except wheelchairs) are prohibited within the large and small dog areas of the park.
13. Owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by their dogs.
14. Only registered dogs and their owners displaying a key card are allowed into the dog park. Please encourage other to pick up a packet at the Crown Point Parks Department Office and register to become a participant user.
15. Report any trespassing or misuse of the Dog Park to the Crown Point Police Department. The Crown Point Police phone number is: (219) 663-2131.
16. Animal abuse will not be tolerated and will be reported to the Crown Point Police Department.

## FEE SCHEDULE

Participant users are required to purchase a permit each calendar year at the Crown Point Parks Department, 183 S. West St.

Permits are valid on a calendar year basis (June 2016 – June 2017). Permits will be available for purchase in June 2016. Permits shall be valid for the calendar year ending in June 2017.

Thereafter, permit issuance to participant users shall be on a calendar basis, no matter when the permit is issued in the calendar year.

Proof of current vaccinations is required. Rabies, Leptospirosis, DHPP (Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus). Bordetella is not mandatory, but is strongly recommended. Proof of current vaccinations must be completed by a Veterinarian or animal clinic.
